Despite the origin of its name this textile wallcovering is totally made in Italy. The fabric is made with the use of a blended fiber yarn weaved on a jacquard loom. The specialty weft is sourced from the fashion industry and has an uneven texture with multiple tone-on-tone color nuances.

The overall texture recalls the background cloth on top of which in ancient history Native Americans indigenous designed their artworks, frequently used as blankets carpets or to simply decorate the interiors of their tents.

With a contemporary but timeless look this wallcovering has a simple but sophisticated aesthetic and would fit lots of different interior design settings. Interpreted in a few light and neutral colors with an additional Aegean blue. This wallcovering has a dense weaving and it's stain repellent and fire retardant.
