




Shibori Blues

Shibori Blues takes its inspiration from this particular technique of tie and dye. Its name evokes ancient and patient gestures, handed down over the centuries by virtuoso artisans, banded over vats of indigo, in which they plunged white silk cloths, cotton or linen patiently and carefully folded and tied together, aimed to create surprising and original abstract designs with a more or less geometrical effect. Shibori Blues proposes a macro chevron design printed on fil posé of mixed linen, as a free interpretation of the typical diagonal lines of the Arashi shibori. Ethnic flavour, yet elegant. The range of colours varies from the traditional Japanese indigo tones to shades of yellow ochre and earth, typical of the African atmosphere.
